

District hospitals

State health minister took an important and public welfare decision that 12 specialist doctors would be appointed in all district hospitals. At the same time society would be formed in all districts, which would send report about the functions of the hospitals directly to the state government. The appointment of specialist doctors would be a great relief to the public who can't have to travel all the way to cities and medical colleges. The patients would get all medical facilities at the district hospitals. The government is facing problem about the doctors not interested to work in rural areas. All efforts of the government are not effective. But there won't be any difficulty to get specialist doctors to work in district headquarters. Mishra should also consider running of mobile hospitals to villages after getting roads constructed to villages. A mobile hospital with doctors can go to villages in one section for treating patients. In this direction also the government has introduced 'Referral Transport' (Ambulance) and 'Janani Express' for pregnant women. These facilities would be made available to all district hospitals.

The state government should take serious note of what are going at the private hospitals and pathology laboratories. These hospitals are asking the patients get all tests done, which, in many cases, are not necessary. These should be curbed by law. At the same time government hospitals should be equipped with most modern equipment and other facilities.
